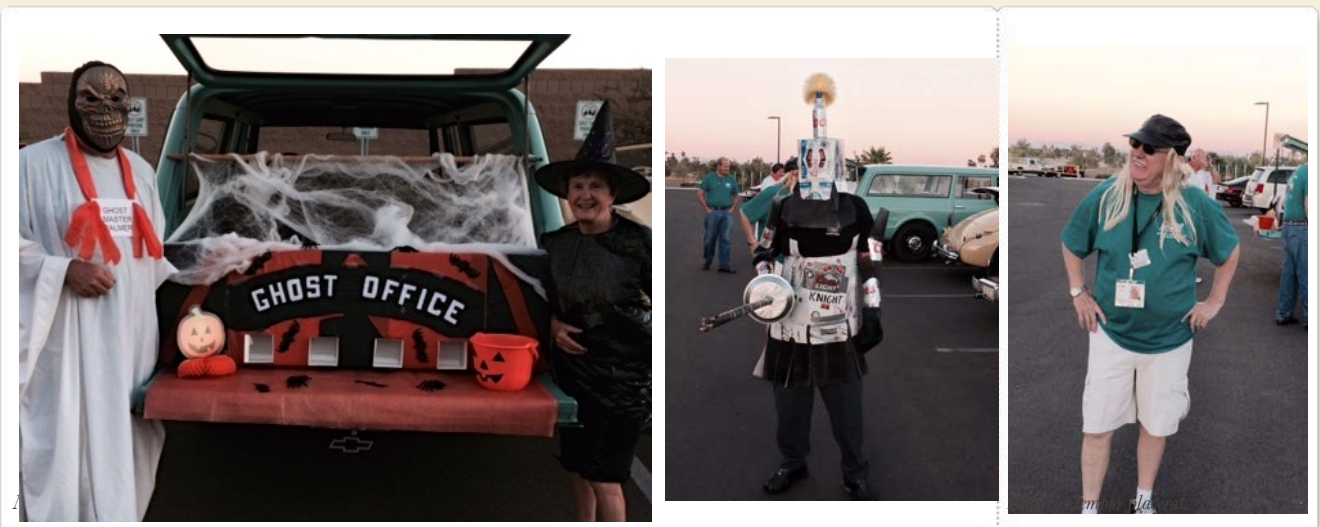
the 3rd Annual John S. Chaney Rock Around the Block Rally. The format has changed this year and it is sure to be a lot of fun.
